

Dome Mountain Environmental Manager Job Description

The Dome Mountain Mine is a small-scale underground gold mine located a one-hour drive outside of Smithers or Tachet BC, which recently received the permits to restart mining. The Mine Environmental Manager at Dome Mountain will have primary responsibility for ensuring the mine is in compliance with all regulatory/legislative requirements relating to environmental protection. The Mine Environmental Manager will also be expected to perform other functions as assigned by Management.

Key responsibilities:

- Ability to work safely and promote safe behaviour in others
- Manage and monitor compliance with internal and external environmental requirements
- Perform weekly, monthly and annual sampling programs and complete required reporting.
- Update management plans and programs to ensure compliance at the minimum of an annual basis.
- Conduct pre-disturbance field surveys and prepare Construction and Environmental Management Plans
- Manage environmental staff and sub-contractors/consultants to achieve timelines, manage budget and quality expectations
- Execute and oversee reclamation activities, planning, reporting and research to achieve long-term reclamation and closure objectives and minimize bond exposure
- Supervise, mentor and train staff in environmental procedures, including operational and emergency/spill response, routine monitoring, management of waste, wildlife, recycling and regulatory compliance
- Implement and update environmental strategies for compliance monitoring, routine/annual reporting, emergency response, staff/contractor environmental orientation training, operational efficiency, regulatory/social/First Nation/stakeholder engagement, and waste reduction
- Assist with water treatment plant operation and compliance

Qualification, Skills and Training

- B. Sc in Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Natural Resource Management or related discipline with 10+ years of experience working on industrial projects in a related field
- Registered in BC with Professional Biologist, Chemist or Geologist designation and qualified to sign off on the above work
- Physically fit, able to navigate with a GPS and compass.

- Strong computer literacy skills (MS Office, GIS mapping software)
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal and time management skills
- Able to work independently with minimal oversight
- Valid drivers license
- Valid Basic First Aid ticket
- Drug and alcohol-free workplace

The candidate may work as a direct employee of Blue Lagoon Resources, but we may also consider hiring a small local consulting firm on a contract basis. Full medical is included for employees. A company truck is provided for this position, if use of a personal vehicle is preferred then mileage will be paid. Schedule is generally Monday to Friday, home every night, but some weekends may be required. Field work will be frequent but need not be daily. Compensation is at a daily rate or hourly equivalent between \$600-\$750 depending on experience.
