

Dome Mountain Mine Geologist Job Description

The Dome Mine is a small-scale underground gold mine located a one-hour drive outside of Smithers or Tachet BC. We recently received the permits to restart mining and are looking to hire motivated staff who will help us achieve our production targets in a safe and environmentally responsible manner. The Mine Geologist at Dome Mountain will have responsibility for ore control and geotechnical mapping and supporting exploration programs as and when needed. The Mine Geologist will also be expected to perform other functions as assigned by Management.

Key responsibilities:

- Ability to work safely and promote safe behaviour in others
- Manage and monitor compliance with internal and external regulatory requirements
- Perform daily, weekly, and monthly sampling programs and complete required reporting.
- Provide daily grade control
- Supervise underground and surface drilling programs
- Manage and record ore and waste movement
- Provide geological information
- Collect mapping data and continually update the geotechnical mine plan
- Collect MLARD samples

- B. Sc in Geology with 5+ years of relevant geoscience experience
- Professional Geologist registered in BC or eligible to register
- Mine Supervisor Certification or higher
- Physically fit, able to navigate with a GPS and compass.
- Strong computer literacy skills (MS Office, GIS mapping software, 3D modeling software (Micromine or Vulcan)
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal and time management skills
- Able to work independently with minimal oversight
- Valid drivers license
- Valid Basic First Aid ticket
- Drug and alcohol-free workplace

The candidate may work as a direct employee of Blue Lagoon Resources, but we may also consider hiring a small local consulting firm on a contract basis. Medical benefits are included for employees. A

company truck is provided for this position, if use of a personal vehicle is preferred then mileage will be paid. Schedule is generally 5 days on 2 days off, home every night. Compensation is at a daily rate or hourly equivalent between \$450-\$750 depending on experience.
