

Dome Mountain Mine Health and Safety Job Description

The Dome Mountain Mine is a small-scale underground gold mine located a one-hour drive outside of Smithers or Tachet BC. We recently received the permits to restart mining and are looking to hire motivated staff who will help us achieve our production targets in a safe and environmentally responsible manner. The Mine Health and Safety Manager at Dome Mountain will have primary responsibility for the Health and Safety programs at the mine site. The Mine Health and Safety Manager will also be expected to perform other functions as assigned by Management.

Key responsibilities:

- Ability to work safely and promote safe behaviour in others
- Implement and enforce the Health and Safety Program
- Manage and monitor compliance with internal and external regulatory requirements
- Conduct routine inspections and audits of work areas to identify potential health hazards, provide corrective actions and complete required reporting.
- Update and sign off on existing Health and Safety documentation

Qualification, Skills and Training

- Awareness of industry standards and legislation applicable to the roll, including but not limited to the Health Safety and Reclamation Code for Mines in BC.
- Solid knowledge of WorkSafe BC regulations
- Past experience in an underground mine
- Able to train and run a mine rescue team
 - Provide information on previous mine rescue teams you have run and mine rescue courses you have taught
- Excellent computer data entry and report writing skills with a high attention to detail to maintain accurate records and create reporting
- Maintain a serviceable and compliant fleet of monitoring equipment in accordance with required standards
- Tertiary qualification in Occupational Hygiene, Science or Health and Safety
- Membership of the Canadian Registration Board of Occupational Hygienist or Health and Safety Professionals Canada
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal and time management skills
- Able to work independently with minimal oversight
- Valid driver's license
- Valid Basic First Aid ticket
- Drug and alcohol-free workplace

The candidate may work as a direct employee of Blue Lagoon Resources, but we may also consider hiring a small local consulting firm on a contract basis. Medical benefits are included for employees. A company truck is provided for this position, if use of a personal vehicle is preferred then mileage will be paid. Our schedule is generally 5 days on 2 days off, home every night. Compensation is at a daily rate or hourly equivalent between \$600-\$750 depending on experience.
